Opening Hymn: 167 HAIL the day that sees him rise, Alleluia,  
**First Reading** **Acts 1: 1-11 (P. 1092)**  
Gradual Hymn: 172 THE head that once was crowned with thorns  
**Gospel:** **Luke 24: 44-end (P. 1062)**  
Offertory Hymn: 170 JESUS is Lord! Creation's voice proclaims it,  
Holy Communion: 293 COME, risen Lord, and deign to be our guest;  
Closing Hymn: 311 LORD, enthroned in heavenly splendour (omit v.3)

**Collect:** Grant, we pray, almighty God, that as we believe your only-begotten Son our Lord Jesus Christ to have ascended into the heavens, so we in heart and mind may also ascend and with him continually dwell; who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. **Amen.**

**Post Communion:** God our Father, you have raised our humanity in Christ and have fed us with the bread of heaven: mercifully grant that, nourished with such spiritual blessings, we may set our hearts in the heavenly places; through Jesus Christ our Lord. **Amen.**
