A few words from Revd Ann

As I walk from the vicarage to church I am seeing evidence of spring, the trees are turning green, the blossom is coming out and the tulips are flowering on the edge of the church path. I have also noticed a change in the churchyard, over Easter many people have visited to lay flowers on ancestors graves, alongside also perhaps pausing to remember and give thanks for the lives of departed loved ones.



In church this month's bible readings, pick up on the theme of grieving and remembering, in John's gospel we read how following Jesus's death, the disciples were huddled together in a locked room, scared and frightened that the authorities who had arrested Jesus would turn their attention onto them next. Suddenly Jesus appeared and stood among them saying, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you." ²²And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit. ²³If you forgive anyone's sins, their sins are forgiven; if you do not forgive them, they are not forgiven."

As Christians we know that through the death and resurrection of Jesus, just when all hope seemed lost, the new life Jesus promised broke through. The despair and fear initially felt by the early disciples was replaced by joy, and that same joy and future hope is available to all of us today. The early followers asked Jesus lots of questions



about what would happen next, and when Jesus spoke to them he told them not to leave Jerusalem until they had received more of the gift he had promised them. This gift would fill them with the power and the confidence to go to every part of the world to talk about their faith. The gift was the Holy Spirit, the third part of the Holy Trinity, 'the Advocate', 'the Comforter', which we know was evident at the festival of Pentecost. The gift of the Holy Spirit was not just for those early disciples, it is a gift that dwells in the hearts and minds of all who have faith in God.

However, Jesus knew before the gift of the Holy Spirit could arrive, he needed to return to his Father so one day, after blessing his disciples, Jesus was taken up into heaven, disappearing from their view, the event of Jesus leaving earth, 'his ascension', is celebrated by Christians exactly forty days after Easter on Ascension Day.

This year we celebrate Ascension Day on Thursday 14th May, at St Mary's Church it is also the date for our Gift Day, the traditional time, something that began many years ago, when the Cubbington village community offer a thanksgiving gift of money as a way of supporting the church. Whilst I recognise that money is tight for all of us this year if you do feel able to call into the church on this day and offer a gift that would be very much appreciated, I think we can all agree that St Mary's is a beautiful church, and by making a donation to support its upkeep, it will enable us to continue its mission, of reaching out, serving and supporting the transformation of the local community.

You are also invited to join us at '**Thursday Pop In**' coffee morning in St Mary's Parish rooms, on the 2nd and 4th Thursdays of each month, 10am – 12noon, a place where you can meet others over a cup of tea or coffee, and also enjoy a slice of homemade cake! This month 'Thursday Pop In' is on 14th May and 28th May.

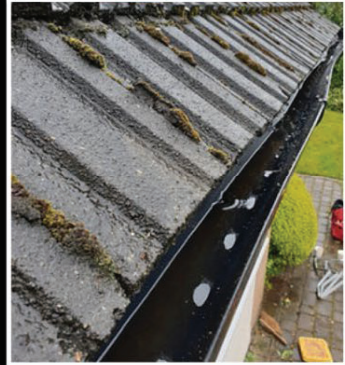

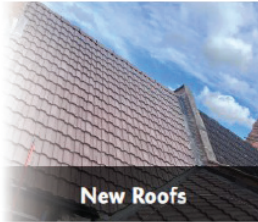

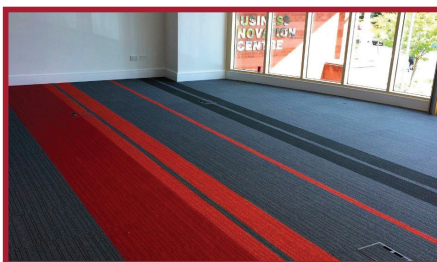
