


**Easter Sunday Service**

## A few words from Revd Ann

This month we are preparing for Easter, as we travel through 'Holy week', I invite you to reflect on how the disciples, who had followed Jesus, must have felt when they journeyed with him up to Jerusalem from Galilee, to celebrate the festival of Passover. When Jesus riding on a donkey entered the noise and the bustle of the big city, surrounded by the crowds crying 'Hosanna', a very real contrast to the peace and quiet of Galilee.



As the week progressed the disciples experienced having their feet washed, were told that one of them was going to betray him and that they would all, including Peter, abandon him. They celebrated the Passover meal with Jesus, watched as he blessed and shared bread and wine, then travelled with him to the Garden of Gethsemane,



saw Jesus being arrested, then later tried, before listening to the crowd cries of 'Crucify him'. They watched their friend Jesus carry his cross, saw him nailed to it and lifted high for all to see, imagine how would it have felt to have been known as one of his followers, the bible stories tell us the women, including his own mother remained with Jesus through his final hours, they stood at the foot of the cross

and watched him die, before religious rules meant they had to leave Jesus laid in a cold tomb and return home to prepare for the Sabbath.



In Marks gospel we read, how the women fearfully walked through the darkened streets to the tomb early in the morning as the Sabbath ended, we know that their bravery was rewarded and they became the bearers of the good news of the next part of the story. How they discovered on that first Easter Sunday morning, the stone rolled away, the tomb was empty, Jesus had risen, he was alive, and had conquered death, just when all seemed lost, the new life Jesus promised broke through, their despair replaced by joy and that same joy is still available to all of us today. We are all called to be as brave as those early female and male followers, to go forth into our communities spreading the good news of God's love.

We continue to invite you to join us at '**Thursday Pop In**' coffee morning in the Parish rooms, which takes place on the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Thursdays of each month, between 10am – 12 noon, a place where you can meet others over a cup of tea or coffee, and also enjoy a slice of homemade cake!



We also invite you all to come and join us to learn more about the Easter Story, at the Family Easter Craft Activity Afternoon on **Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> March 2-4pm** in the Parish Rooms a time when we can all come together and make things for Easter. On **Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> March at 10am** you are all welcome to join us for our All-Age Communion Service to celebrate Jesus triumphant entry into Jerusalem on Palm Sunday. As a church we will gather together during Holy week to reflect again on the Gospel passages that tell the story of Jesus final week on earth, you are welcome to travel with us, on **Wednesday, Maundy Thursday and Good Friday**. Before celebrating together Jesus's resurrection on **Easter Sunday, with a special All-Age Communion service at 10am**, as the tower work has been completed the bells will once again ring out joyfully to announce Alleluia, Christ is risen, He is risen indeed Alleluia.


