GREETINGS FROM THE VICARAGE

Dear Friends

I hope this finds you well and despite the rather wet weather that we have been having, you have been able to get out and enjoy the odd sunny day. Like most British people we like to moan about the weather but when it does rain, I smile at those who say, "well we could do with it for the gardens". Of course, this is true and the fact that we live in a country that has different seasons we are very fortunate whereas some countries have extremes of weather, too much or too little rain etc.

I don't know if you have one of those apps on your phone or commuter that pops up and tells you what you were doing on this day several years ago. I don't have one but my daughter has and she messaged me this week to tell me that 4 years ago today we were in Jerusalem. I knew it was around this time that I made my second visit to the Holy Land because I was prompted by seeing the horrendous fighting taking place. What shocked me most was seeing that many of the places that featured in their news reports were where 4 years ago I had walked with Sophie.

I know that the disputes between Israelis and Palestinians have been a very long and ongoing issue. On my first visit we made a point of visiting people from both sides of the dispute and hearing from each their own point of view. As I'm sure you are aware, it mostly comes down to the ownership of land and it really depends on how far back in history you want to go to decide who is the rightful owner.

I personally feel for the Palestinians as they seem to be the ones who are constantly losing their homes. I visited sites where houses once stood only to find a pile of rubble. Unlike in our country there are very few people who have a copy of deeds for their property; the transaction of buying their home was a 'verbal agreement' and a handshake. When the bulldozer turns up to knock down their home, they have no way of proving it belongs to them.

I spent a day in the town of Ramallah in the centre of the West Bank visiting a School and a Technical College where we were treated like royalty. We had a full tour of the school visiting every classroom and speaking to the children. At lunchtime we ate with the pre-school children in their nursery. At the end of the day a Nun who looked after the pre-school children took us in her car and after giving us a tour of the town dropped us at the bus stop for us to catch a bus, back through the check point into Jerusalem where we were staying.

On the news last night, I saw pictures of the fighting in Ramallah, the main street that we had walked along to find the school. When I visited, it was pointed out to us how they were still rebuilding the town after the previous fighting. It is very difficult for us to imagine what those dear people must be living through; how do you go about your daily life with the threat of violence and death at every corner?

Do please hold both sides and all the people who live in the Holy Land in your prayers. Praying for an end to this senseless violence where no one or side wins, and where there is only pain and suffering for ordinary people. Give thanks that we have the joy of living in such a beautiful and safe place and have no real idea of what war and fighting is truly like and where all we have to moan about is the rain!

A grant application has been submitted to Warwickshire County Council's Green Shoot Scheme. If successfully awarded the parish council will continue with the climate change planting scheme.

Dogs on the Recreation Ground

Unfortunately, despite polite requests the increase in dog fouling has continued. We also cannot stress enough how important it is that dog owners follow the rule and note that no dogs are permitted in the playground area. This includes taking a short cut across the play equipment to walk from the Village Hall to Boddington Close. All dogs must be on a lead when in this area too!

Currently dogs are permitted and welcome on the Recreation Ground on the "field" part. Please be responsible and pick up after your dog, we have had a significant increase in dog fouling. There are sufficient bins to deposit your waste in. It is not acceptable to expect Council members to pick up after your dog.

The Parish Council will start prosecuting people who do not pick up after their dog.


