St. Mary's Church Remembrance Sunday 12th November at 11.00am



Dear friends,

As October draws to a close and the clocks go back the long dark evenings stretch in front of us and the importance of light can be seen to show us the way. Jesus is the light of the world showing us how to live and respond to those around us. The darkness seems to be creeping in with both rumours and actual wars kicking off around the world. It seems that we never learn from history. Following the First World War and then the Second World War



people said it would never happen again but within a few years we were at each other's throats in different parts of the world.

We're coming into a season of remembrance both with All Souls day when we remember those who we've loved and lost and remembrance time when we reflect on the sacrifices of those who gave their lives that we might have a good life now and peace. Armistice Day is remembered on the 11th of November at the 11th hour and as a community we will come together on the 12th of November to remember those who died serving their country.



I wonder what you remember about those you've loved and lost? Is there something or a place that particularly reminds you of the person who you have lost? Their influence on our lives continue even though they are not with us and they have shaped us into the people we are. The same is true as we think about our own nation and its involvement across the years fighting for freedom. Unfortunately war can brutalise and anesthetise our reactions to what is happening in the world today. Violence on all parts leads to further violence as people remember what has been done to them in the past and seek revenge. This is a very human reaction but God wants us to be different and

to recognise that the cycle of violence will only lead to more violence. At the heart of the Christian message is the message of forgiveness and love. This is not always easy and applies to our daily lives as well as a world picture.

Jesus said to his friends and to us: "As the Father has loved me, so have I loved you. Now remain in my love. If you keep my commands, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commands and remain in his love. I have told you this so that my joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. My command is this: love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. You are my friends if you do what I command." (John 15:9-14). These words are hard words if we look at them in depth and is a challenge to us all and our attitudes and behaviours.

To forget the past, means we don't learn from it, but the past has made us who we are. So at this time of remembrance let us remember with love and thankfulness those we have lost and those who have given their lives for our country and what they believe. May the light that comes from Jesus' words show us away to live, forgiving others and learning to love one another.



There are opportunities for you to remember and to give thanks for those you've loved at the All Soul's Service on the 29th of October at 6:00pm, all are invited.

Remembrance Day service starts with a parade to the War Memorial from the centre of the village at 10:45. This is followed by an act of remembrance at the War Memorial and then a short service in church which is open to all.

Take our well-developed curriculum to the next level of maturity, ensuring a consistent and effective approach to formative and summative assessment across all subjects in all stages and ongoing development of subject expertise, consistently achieving outcomes above the national average and being recognised as local leaders.
- 3. Continue to build partnerships to deepen our inclusive, nurturing and caring approach to all, from pupils to staff to volunteers; working with parents, our local church and community organisations to support our spiritual growth and bring greater diversity of resources, perspectives and experiences into our provision.
- 4. Place our pupils' voices at the heart of what we do, from curriculum development to everyday interactions, ensuring that children feel and know their innate value and agency.
- 5. Collaborate with other schools and providers to enable greater access to Cubbington's highquality provision, maintaining a strong financial position to support ongoing investment in the quality of education.




