St. Mary's Church Remembrance Sunday Sunday 9th November



A few words from Revd Ann



As we mark, by altering the clocks, the end of British summertime, the dark mornings and evenings act as a reminder that the earth's birds, animals and plants are preparing to hibernate, as a gardener I am aware that the time is coming when some of the plants in the vicarage

garden will die down before returning again in the spring.

As a church we are coming to the end of this Liturgical year, we are entering into a season of Remembrance, firstly by gathering together to personally remember and

give thanks for those whom we have individually loved and lost at the All-Souls Service, (Sunday 2nd November at 6pm). This last year I have had the privilege of journeying alongside many who having lost a loved one, and I offer an invitation to you all to join with us at St Mary's, to pause, remember and give thanks for their individual lives, during the service if you wish you will have an opportunity to light a candle as a visual act of personal remembrance.





Then secondly by gathering together as a community to corporately remember and give thanks for all those who made the ultimate sacrifice, of laying down their lives for our freedom. On Remembrance Sunday, 9th November at 10.45am, I invite you to join us as we gather around the war memorial, before pausing in the silence to reflect and remember with grateful hearts those who gave so much.

Then as the month of November progresses, as a church our thoughts turn to the start of a new liturgical year, we enter into Advent, a time of repentance and preparation. You are all welcome on Sunday 30th November at 6pm as we gather together at St Mary's to begin our Advent journey, as we take time to pause, reflect and begin to prepare our hearts and minds in readiness to celebrate the birth of the Christ Child, God's gift to all of humanity.



As I finish, I am also sure many of you will have noticed as you walk through the churchyard that the area around the tower has been cordoned off, and may not know why this has occurred. On Tuesday 30th September one of the stone finials fell off a corner of the church tower, the falling stonework, before hitting the ground damaged the church roof. Thankfully nobody was walking through the church at the moment it came down, although I understand it did make a loud

noise!

We were very fortunate with the help of the stone mason, and others, the broken tiles on the church roof were replaced, meaning the building was watertight before 'Storm Amy' arrived the following weekend.

As I write this, our insurance company requires the area to be cordoned off, hence the tape which must not be moved or removed as without it our insurance is in-valid. We are also currently waiting for a drone to assess the damage and see if the other stone finials on the tower are safe, the outcome of this will establish next steps, which in turn will determine when we can remove the cordon and also once again ring the church bells.
