## A few words from Revd Ann

For many, June marks the start of summer, arriving with longer days and hopefully warm sunshine, as the month progresses the nights get lighter until we reach the longest day. In June the scent of Roses is starting to fill the air, the seeds planted in the spring are growing into strong plants, everywhere there is a sense of expectancy and hope.



June is also the month the United Nations chose to establish 'World Environment Day', a day that has been held annually since 5<sup>th</sup> June 1972, in order to raise awareness of environmental issues across the globe, the day has previously focused on a particular environmental issue, such as wildlife conservation, climate change, or our vital connection to nature. This year theme, 'Climate Action' is a call to every nation, community and individual, that the moment to act is now.



For others June is a time of transitions, as I was in Cublington school this morning I saw the year 6 children in their leavers hoodies and recognised for them, having just completed important tests, the next steps in their education journey is preparing to move from a small school to a much larger one. For older students June is the season of revision and sitting examinations, before then waiting over the summer for results which will decide next steps in individual life journeys.

June for the church is also a season of transition, the major festivals of Lent, Easter, Ascension and Pentecost have been celebrated and our liturgy moves into Ordinary time, which is symbolised by all of our Altar linens and Vestments changing to green. Green is often recognised as the colour that symbolises new life and growth, as individuals it is the time when we are invited to consider what aspect of the Christian life we are planning on nurturing or developing. I invite you to join us for a service at St Mary's Church, or contact me if you want to further explore more about finding or further developing a faith in God.




At St Mary's Church June is also a time of celebration as on **Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> June from 2.30pm** we are holding our **Summer Fayre** at the Village Hall, to which you are all warmly invited.

As we move further into the summer term, it feels like the perfect moment to reflect on what has already been an incredibly full and rewarding term for our school community. The children were fascinated by the experience of stepping back in time, learning about the role of railways during the war while enjoying the unique atmosphere of the steam journey. Another particularly exciting adventure was the Year 5 visit to the Harry Potter experience, which sparked imagination and creativity across the year groups. The children were captivated by the behind-the-scenes insights and thoroughly enjoyed seeing familiar scenes brought to life.

Closer to home, our Year 1 pupils also explored St John's Museum in Warwick, where they engaged with local history in a hands-on and meaningful way. It was wonderful to see them asking thoughtful questions and making connections to their classroom learning.

Sport has also played a major part in our summer term. Key Stage 2 Sports Day was a fantastic celebration of teamwork, effort, and school spirit. The children demonstrated great determination in all events, cheering each other on and showing excellent sportsmanship throughout the day. It was uplifting to see such enthusiasm and support from both pupils and spectators.

In addition to Sports Day, many pupils have represented the school in a variety of sporting competitions and events. From athletics to team sports, their commitment and positive attitude have been commendable. These opportunities not only promote physical wellbeing but also build confidence and resilience.

Alongside these highlights, the daily life of the school continues to be filled with learning, creativity, and laughter. Classrooms have been buzzing with activity, and it has been a pleasure to see the progress pupils are making across all subjects.

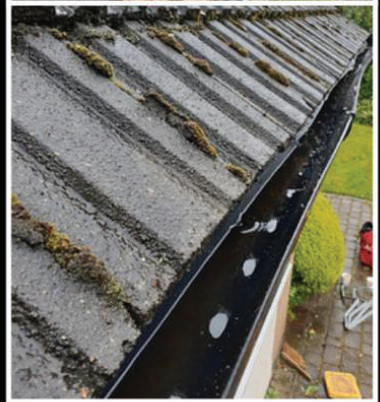

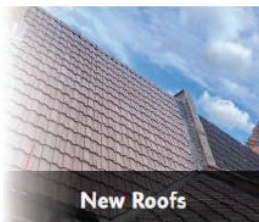

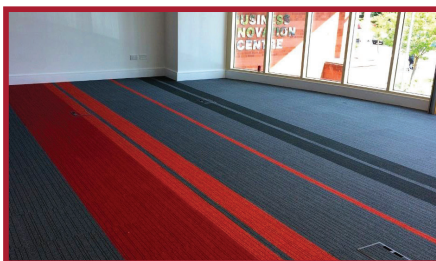
